Some facts about oak trees



There are many types of oak trees. The white oak, the kind in this book, can live to be several hundred years old.



By counting the rings on the stump of a cut tree, you can tell how old it was: one year for each ring.



Oak trees can produce acorns when they are as young as ten years old. The hard-shelled acorn contains the seed from which a new tree grows.



Oak trees can grow to be one hundred feet tall AND wide. Oaks are good shade trees.

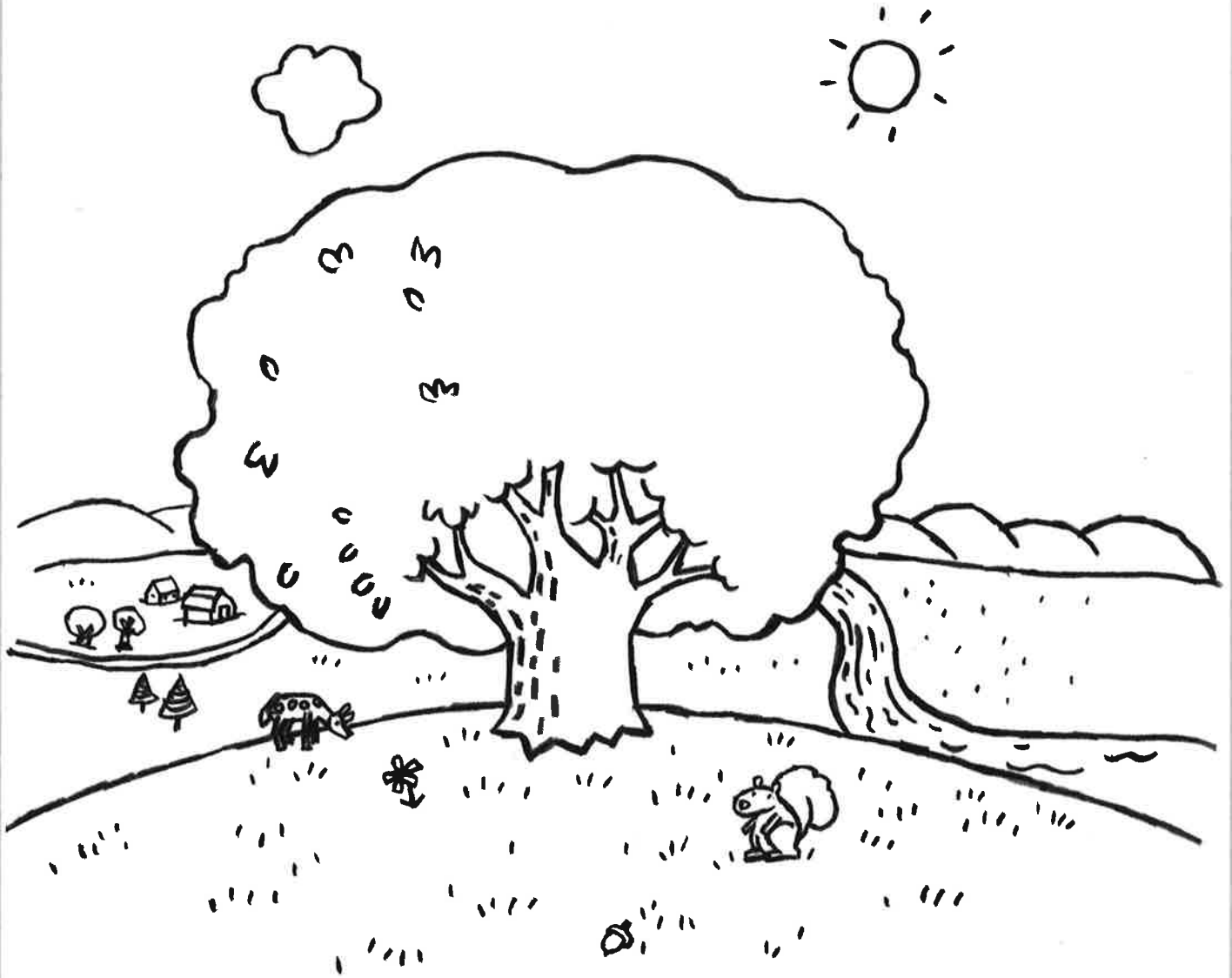


Acorns are an important food source for animals and insects, and people too.

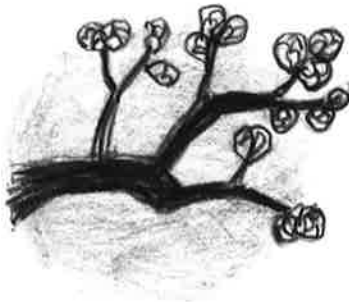

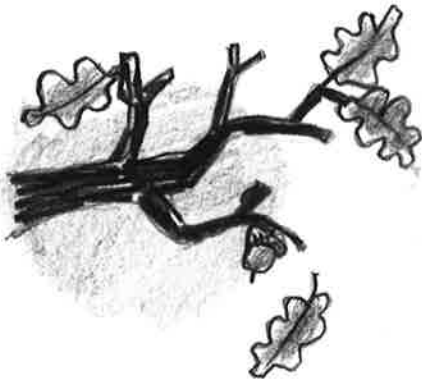
