Bilingual Read Aloud with Music - "Mi Comunidad / My Community" - Community Helpers Song

Andrés and Christina are 123 Andrés, a Latin Grammy-winning music duo with catchy songs for kids, in Spanish and English. They tour nationally, with shows for audiences from early childhood through elementary. Andrés and Christina bring dance moves, humor, and singable tunes for kids to dance – and to lure adults onto the dance floor, too!

Children and members of their families join Andrés on an exciting cultural seminar of Latin American through an introduction of language, music and dance. Families will sing, shake, and sound out rhythms while gaining knowledge of vocabulary in English and Spanish. Children will be encouraged to use their imaginations to ride imaginary airplane and join in singing songs that will entice dance while practicing new vocabulary.
